Approximately:

- For the Spring semester, the enrollment period starts Oct 1st Nov 30th and classes begin January 15th and end on June 10th
- For the Fall Semester, the enrollment period is from April1st May 30th and classes begin on August 8th and end late in November or first week of December.

All migratory documents of the international student should be turned in to the admissions office no later than 2 months after arrival.
